Lanier Dance will help students develop perception, creative expression/performance, historical and cultural heritage, critical evaluation, and perceptual thinking and moving abilities in daily life that promote an understanding of themselves and others. The curriculum emphasizes participation in body movement and awareness, conditioning, movement principals and skills, self-discipline, and healthy bodies that move expressively and safely through the space and time.

Movement is taught using ballet, jazz, modern, lyrical, hip hop, international dance, teambuilding, health concepts, and dance/drill team techniques.

Mrs. Kornegay started the dance program at Lanier in 1993. The program has grown to over 240 students.

She has danced professionally in Houston with modern dance, jazz, and hip hop, and was an NFL Cheerleader in 1993. Mrs. Kornegay has taught and adjudicated for Marching Auxiliaries for over 10 years. She was influential in developing the junior high officer leadership camp with MA Dance in 2008.
