Literacy 8 is taught through the structure of Readers/Writers Workshop and is based on the Columbia University Lucy Calkins model. Students learn meaningful strategies to help them become more skillful readers and writers. They learn how to communicate effectively through units of study ranging from memoir, fiction, personal essay, poetry, and investigative journalism. Students are engaged in independent reading throughout the year and participate in book clubs during the second semester.
