I am the proud parent of two Lanier (and Lamar) graduates. I began teaching French at Lanier in 1998 but moved into the technology department the following year. Currently, I serve as the IB-MYP lead teacher for technology.

I earned a B.A. (French) from Oberlin College, M. A. (French) Bowling Green State University, and M.B.A. (International Business and Marketing) Tulane University.

- **Media Team** is organized into four nine-week courses (web design, art/animation, media literacy, and videography). I teach web design starting with an introductory tutorial to HTML and culminating with an interdisciplinary web site project.
- **Technology Applications 7th Grade** is a semester-long course. During the first nine weeks students learn web design; the second nine weeks is when students learn how to create an enhanced podcast. There is an interdisciplinary project that incorporates Photo Story 3, PowerPoint, and various other software tools.
- **Technology Applications 8th Grade** is a semester-long course offering advanced topics (special problems) in technology.
- **6B Study Lab** offers students mini-lessons in keyboarding, MS Office applications, and online research.
